

# 2022 RAMADAN CHALLENGE **SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS - FINAL**

DUBAI AUTODROME MOTOR SPORTS CLUB, PO Box 57331, Dubai, UAE will organise the 2019 Ramadan Challenge on the below dates;

Round 1 - 5th of April 2022 - The Hill Circuit Round 2 - 12<sup>th</sup> of April 2022 - Reverse Hill

Round 3 - 19th of April 2022 - International circuit

Round 4 - 26th of April 2022 - Reverse International Circuit

The Ramadan Challenge will be organized by the DAMC and will follow for all four rounds the 2022 Dubai Kartdrome Sodi World Series Sprint Races Sporting Regulations and the 2022 RAMADAN CHALLENGE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS - FINAL.

The final text of the Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version, which will be used in the case of any dispute arising as to their interpretation. Heading in this document are for ease and reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Junior Cup, Senior Cup & Masters Rounds will be held at the Dubai Kartdrome Outdoor CIK Circuit, as per track layout specified above.

#### 1. **FNTRIFS**

Early Bird Race Entries can be paid online <a href="www.dubaiautodrome.com">www.dubaiautodrome.com</a> or e-mail <a href="purificacaop@dubaiautodrome.com">purificacaop@dubaiautodrome.com</a> or can be paid at Outdoor Reception 10 days prior to Round 1.

#### 1.1 **ENTRY CRITERIA**

JUNIOR CUP: 7 years and above, up to a maximum age of 14 years old and must have done a minimum of 10 indoor arrive and drive sessions previously. In addition to this, drivers must weigh a minimum of 50kg with safety equipment (driver, suit, gloves, boots & helmet).

SENIOR CUP: Every entrant must be 15 years and over and weigh a minimum of 85kg.

\*Drivers 13yrs and above, whom are 50kg and have a competition license can enter

MASTERS CATEGORY (OF SENIOR CUP): Every entrant must be 35 years old and over and weigh a minimum of 95kg. with safety equipment (driver, suit, gloves, boots & helmet)

\*Note for all classes: Rib protectors, neck braces, seat inserts and kart ballast are not considered part of the drivers weight during official weigh in, hence will not be accepted.

\*NB: Each Senior & Master category entrants must have posted a minimum lap time of 1 min 15 seconds on the outdoor circuit's International configuration, during any arrive and drive session, in order to be eligible to enter this race.

\*Drivers can use the kart weight ballast provided to reach the minimum weight limit.

#### 1.2 PAYMENTS:

There is an 'early bird Entry fee' (for all four rounds & Early bird entries guarantee entry to all four rounds of the Ramadan Challenge) Junior Cup Early Bird fee is AED 1680 per driver inc VAT Senior Cup Early Bird fee is AED 1995 per driver inc VAT

- All entries received after the <u>3<sup>rd</sup> of April</u> will be charged as follows: 1.3
- Junior Cup AED 495 per round inc of 5% VAT Senior Cup AED 595 per round inc of 5% VAT
- Early bird payments are non transferable and no refund will be given if no show. 1.4
- No refunds or credit against future races will be given on the individual entries, for late comers or no show. 1.5
- STARTERS: The maximum number of entries permitted per Ramadan Challenge Round is: 34 x Seniors and 29 x Juniors 1.6
- The OFFICAL NOTICE BOARD will be displayed: Under the Canopy at the Outdoor Kartdrome 1.7
- 1.8 Time Schedule of Events: Timetable will be displayed on official Notice board and website.

#### 2.1 Junior Cup Format

Limited to 29 drivers entering

## Practice & Qualifying – 8 minutes

- Race 1 --> (Drivers will start as as per their official classified Qualfiying result) Race Laps as stipulated on timetable
- **Race 2** --> (Top 5 driver's from Race1 will have their start positions reversed)
- Race 3 --> (Top 10 driver's from Race2 will have their start positions reversed)

### 3.0 Senior Cup & Masters Format:

Limited to 34 drivers entering

### Practice & Qualifying - 8 minutes

- Race 1 --> (Drivers will start as as per their official classified Qualfiying result) Race Laps as stipulated on timetable
- **Race 2** --> (Top 5 driver's from Race1 will have their start positions reversed)
- Race 3 --> (Top 10 driver's from Race2 will have their start positions reversed)

#### 4.0: POINT SCORING:

**4.1:** The organisers will keep track of each competitor's finishing results during the races, using the point system shown below. These points will be awarded for each heat and added together. The highest total will determine the Outright Winner of the Day.

### 4.2: <u>Tie on Points:</u>

Should there be competitors drawn on equal points, then the winner will be decided by the number of higher finishing's in either of the races. In the event there is still a draw, it will be decided as per the higher finishing in official Qualifying.

**SWS World Ranking Points:** The Ramadan Challenge will count towards the SWS World Rankings and those drivers registered with the SWS World Series, their points will be allocated as per the point scoring system defined by the SodiWSeries regulations.

\*For both Junior Cup and Senior Sprint Cup: TWO sets of SWS points will be forwarded to the official SWS Championship, as per the official classified result from Race 1. The second set of SWS Points will be the overall ranking of the day.

**4.4:** Ramadan Championship Points: Each Ramadan Challenge competitor will score "Ramadan Championship Points", to determine the overall Championship Ranking after 4 rounds. These points are listed in **SR. 4.5**

- 4.6 There will be an additional Ramadan Championship points for the driver setting Pole Position during Qualifying and the Fastest Lap on the night, for both Junior Cup and Seniors, in all four Rounds.
- 4.7 In the case of 2 drivers are having the same number of points, they will be separated with regards to the following elements: Number of 1st places, 2nd places, 3rd places and so as per rounds.
  Number of pole positions, 2nd places, 3rd places and so on in qualifying sessions.
  Result of the last race.

# 5.0 MASTERS CATEGORY (OF SENIOR CUP)

- **5.1:** Any driver wishing to register and compete within the Masters category must be **35** years of age or older.
- **5.2**: There will be award presentations given to the top three scoring Masters at each round.
- **5.3**: The top 3 Masters will be selected from the overall classifications after the finals, where the highest placed masters on the night will be declared winners.
- 5.4 Kindly note SWS World Rankings do not operate a Masters Category, so any points you get will be based on your overall ranking from Senior.

  Masters category is solely a Dubai Autodrome concept.









- 6.0: PRIZES:
- For each of the Champions Junior, Senior & Masters each will receive a Dubai Kartdrome FIA Karting Suit made to measure, curtosy of Dojomoto Racing.
- 6.2 **Junior SWS** The <u>2022 Ramadan Junior Champion</u> will get a <u>Free race entry</u> into either an IAME or Rotax event during the 2022 'Summer Cup' curtosy of Dojomoto Racing.
- 6.3 <u>Junior SWS Highest placed finisher</u> who has not participated within the IAME Challenge before, will get a <u>Free race entry</u> into IAME Cadet or IAME Junior during the 2022 'Summer Cup', curtosy of IAME & RAK TRACK UAE.
- 6.4 **Seniors SWS** <u>Highest placed finisher</u> who has not participated within the IAME Challenge before, will get a <u>Free race entry</u> into IAME Senior or IAME X30 Master during the during the 2021 'Summer Cup', curtosy of IAME & RAK TRACK UAE. Should any races be postponed this prize will carry over into the 2021/22 National Championship.
- 6.5 Master SWS <u>Highest placed finisher</u> who has not participated within the IAME Challenge before, will get a <u>Free race entry</u> into IAME Senior or IAME X30 Master during the during the 2021 'Summer Cup', curtosy of IAME & RAK TRACK UAE. Should any races be postponed this prize will carry over into the 2021/22 National Championship.
- 6.6 Top 10 Juniors Free test day in an IAME Mini Go Kart
- 6.7 Top 10 Seniors Free test day in an IAME X30 Go kart
- 6.8 Top 10 Master Free Test day in an IAME X30 Go Kart
- 7.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PRIZES:
- 7.1: Should any prize winner entitled one of the prizes awarded not wish to utilize them, they are to inform Dubai Autodrome Management, who will award the said prize to the next highest competitor.
